

Glossary:

- Season: four divisions of the year, noticeable by particular weather patterns.
- Summer: the warmest season of the year
- Autumn: the season after summer and before winter
- Winter: the coldest season of the year
- Spring: The season after winter before summer
- Climate: the weather conditions in an area.
- Temperature: a measurement of how hot or cold something is
- Extreme weather: a weather event that is significantly different to the usual weather pattern.
- Capital city: Where the government operates from.
- Global warming: a gradual increase in the overall temperature of the Earth's atmosphere.
