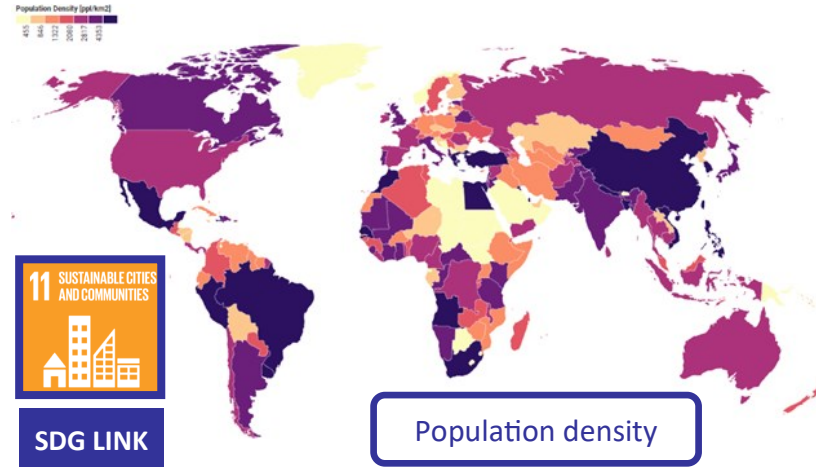


Glossary:

- Population - The number of people in a single area
- Population distribution – the pattern of where people live
- Densely populated – areas that crowded with people
- Sparsely populated - areas that contain few people
- Megacity – a city with a population of over 10 million
- Birth rate – number of individuals born in a population in a given amount of time
- Death rate - number of deaths to the population in a given amount of time
- Natural increase – the difference between number of births and number of deaths recorded over a period of time.
- Urbanisation – the process of making an area more urban
- Migration – seasonal movement of animals from one region to another
- Economy – the state of a country or region in terms of production and consumption of good and services and supply of money.
