Glossary:

- River a flowing, moving stream of water
- Continents- is a large solid area of land
- Symbols one object or thing stands in the place of something
- Source the start of a river is it's source
- Water cycle the continuous journey of water from oceans and lakes, to clouds, to rain, to Streams, to rivers and back into the ocean again
- Evaporation happens when a liquid turns into a gas
- Condensation process by which a gas (water vapour) turns back into a liquid
- Precipitation any liquid or frozen water that forms in the atmosphere and falls to the Earth
- Meander a bend in a river channel
- River Basin—an area of land drained by a river and its
 tributaries


