

Dome




Volcano

Glossary:

- Latitude A measurement on a globe or map of location north or south of the Equator.
- Longitude Imaginary lines that run around the Earth vertically (up and down) and meet at the North and South Poles.
- Tectonic plate Tectonic plates are pieces of the rocky outer layer of the Earth known as the crust.
- Equator- An equator is an imaginary line around the middle of a planet or other celestial body
- **Tributary** A tributary is a stream or river that flows into and joins a main river
