

## **Glossary:**

- Condensation the conversion of a vapour or gas to a liquid
- **Precipitation** rain, snow, sleet, or hail that falls to or condenses on the ground



- Infiltration when water moves into the ground from the surface and begins to soak into the soil and rock
- Impermeable not allowing fluid to pass through
- Permeable allowing fluid to pass through
- Surface the outside limit or top layer of something
- Runoff precipitation that did not get (infiltrated) absorbed into the soil or did not evaporate
- Channel a length of water wider than a strait, joining two larger areas of water
- Floodplain nearly flat surface close to the bed of a river or stream
- **Deforestation** used to describe the actions of humans in removing forests from the planet
- Confluence meeting of two or more waterways
- Embankments a wall or bank of earth or stone built to prevent a river flooding an area
- Flood barrier a barrier built across a river, stream, or estuary to retain
  water
