

Glossary:

- Country land that is controlled by a single government.
- Trade The action of buying and selling goods and services.
- Import Bring (goods or services) into a country from abroad for sale.
- Export Send (goods or services) to another country for sale.
- Global Relating to the whole world.
- Supply chain Is the amount of something which someone has or which is available to use.
- Primary Extracting the raw materials (farming, mining, fishing)
- Secondary Turning raw materials into products (wood to furniture)
- Tertiary Services are provided to businesses (distribution to retailers)
- Climate The weather conditions prevailing in an area in general or over a long period.
- Natural resources materials or substances occurring in nature which can be exploited for economic gain.
- Human resources set of people who make up the workforce of an organisation.
- Fairtrade Trade between companies in developed countries and producers in developing countries in which fair prices are paid to the producers.
- Technology the machinery and equipment used form the application of scientific knowledge.
