

## Year 1 - History - How did Florence Nightingale change and develop the nursing profession?



### Glossary:

- **Chronological:** the arrangement of events or dates in the order they occurred.
- **Primary source:** is an artefact, document, diary, manuscript, recording or any other source of information that was created at this time in History.
- **Secondary source:** Is a source created by someone who did not experience first-hand. These can be books and articles.
- **Artefacts:** an object by a human being, typically of historical interest.
- **Hypothesis:** a suggested explanation made on the basis of limited evidence.
- **Influence:** having an effect on someone or something. Can be positive or negative.
- **Legacy:** Something handed down from an ancestor.
