
## **Glossary:**

- Monarch a ruler such as a king, queen, or emperor.
- **Reign** the period of time that a monarch (a king, queen, emperor, etc.) rules over a country.
- **Coronation** a ceremony that gives a monarch regal or royal power.
- Jubilee a special anniversary of an event, especially one celebrating twenty-five or fifty years of a reign or activity
- Role a part played by a person or thing in a particular situation.
- **Responsibility** -duties or something an individual should
- National Anthem- a song that the people of a country use to remember and respect their country.
- **Heir** a person who has legal claim to a title or a throne when the person holding it dies.
- tradition customs or actions handed down from one generation to another
- **Empire** a set of lands or regions that are ruled by an emperor.
- **Commonwealth** a voluntary association of sovereign states that acknowledge the British monarch as symbolic head.
- Parliament the group of (usually) elected

politicians or other people who make the laws for their country
