
Year 4 - History - How did Ancient Greece influence the modern Western world?





Glossary:

- Civilisation: the society, culture and way of life of an area.
- City state: a city where its territory forms an independent state of rule.
- Agora: a Greek marketplace.
- Olympiad: a period of 4 years between Olympic games.
- Pentathlon: an athletic event comprising of five different sporting disciplines.
- Parliament a group of people who make the laws for a country.
- Democracy a government that is run by the people.
- Empire a set of lands or regions that are ruled by an emperor.
- Conquer- to gain control of through great force.
- Invasion- to enter as an enemy, by force, in order to conquer.
- Commemorate- to honour the memory of.
- Legacy = something that exists as a direct result of a period of history and that continues to exist after the period is over.
- Significant = something that is large enough to be important and taken notice of.
