

Autumn Term 2023



- First day of term Wednesday 6th September
 2023 for all North Worcester Pupils.
- Arrival from 8:20am, registration at 8:30am, via the wooden fenced pathway, parents may come up to the classroom for the first couple of weeks of term.
- Collection at **3:00pm**, please wait on the forest school pathway, the gate be opened at approximately 2:50pm for you to enter the playground for your child to be released to you.
- Friends 'Catch up and Coffee' date and time to be confirmed



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Pupil Premium (additional funding)...



- All pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a hot school meal under the 'Universal Free School Meals' scheme.
- Some pupils will also be <u>entitled</u> to an additional grant of up to £1,455 by claiming for 'Free School Meals'. This money is used by the school to provide additional educational provision the office can help you to apply for this or find out more via this website... <u>Free school meals | Worcestershire County Council</u>
- Applications are treated <u>confidentially</u> and your child will not be aware of this designation.
- Please let the school know if your child has been adopted or has either parent who is a serving member of the armed forces, as this will also trigger an additional payment.

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School Uniform...



- Grey skirt, trousers or shorts
- Purple polo shirt
- Purple sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan (embroidered)
- Black, sensible <u>flat</u> shoes (not boots or trainers)
- Grey tights
- Dark, plain socks
- Grey pinafore dress or purple/white checked summer dress
- Coat / jacket (any colour)
- Long hair should be tied up using a plain hair bobble

Please note: No jeans or other fashion type trousers will be allowed.

Plain stud earrings are permitted. However for safety reasons these should be removed for PE and no other jewellery should be worn at school.

- Pupils are entitled to free milk until their 5th birthday.

Wraparound care

- Wrap lead Mrs Diane Moss
- 7:30am to 8:30am each morning, breakfast is included up until 8am.
- 3:00pm to 6pm, with a snack and light tea (after 4pm).
- Wrap is booked on a monthly basis, in advance, through ParentPay (ie book by 17th August for September wrap).
- If staffing ratios allow we always try to accommodate late and 'adhoc' bookings, but the expectation is that parents book in advance.
- •Payment either directly on ParentPay or with childcare vouchers.
- •Food allergies/ dietary requirements form on website
- Price, booking and payment details on our website.



Attendance

- Attendance is important; days off school = lost learning
- School target is 97%
- ▶ Register taken at 8.30am, school gates open at 8.20am
- If you are late, please enter school via the school office
- Attendance of 90% or less is classed as 'persistently absent' and we will contact you to support you in improving your child's attendance
- We will send you a text message at the end of each half term to inform you of your child's current level of attendance



Absence

- ▶ Illness please call the school by 8.50am with the reason for your child's absence.
- Please call every day of illness absence
- Sickness & diarrhoea 48 hours
- If we don't hear from you we will call you.
- ▶ If we still cannot reach you, we may make a home visit.
- Medication bring to the office, complete a medical form (please don't take to teachers or leave in your child's book bag)
- ► Leave of absence/ holiday request form from school office. Holiday during term time will not be agreed.

What are the benefits


Physical - encourage active travel for children and their families; access to fresh air and exercise as part of a daily routine


Social - cycling as part of a group will build links between families local to each other and between classes and year groups within school


Environmental - Bicycle riding is a pollution-free mode of transport
