Stop Motion software

1. Click 'New Project'

Take 10 photos of the start image before you move any objects.


Onion Skin
Use the Grid and Onion Skin controls to help you position animated objects more easily and precisely. The onion skin allows you to see several frames at once. This way, you can position the current image based on the previous frame.

Ever so often press play to see if you are happy with your animation



Capture images. Try not to press too hard otherwise the iPad will shake.

When you've finished click the arrow key to start the next project.

Project settings: Choose 4/5 frames per second. The more frames the smoother the process but will need lots more photos




Individual images from a jumping mouse animation

- Folder - a group of files that are stored together on a computer

- crop - If you crop something such as a picture, you cut out parts of the image
- app - A program or tool used on digital devices like tablet or smart phone.
- program - A list of instructions a computer can understand.
