



Glossary:

- Article - the word that goes in front of a noun, the word "the" (el, la, los, las)
- Gender - all nouns have a gender— they are either masculine or feminine.
- Singular - a single noun, one thing / person / place.
- Plural – more than one noun / person / place
- Subject - subject pronouns replace the specific names of people or things I, he, she (yo, él, ella)
- Verb - indicates an action (to walk, to run, to go)
- Conditional tense – to say what you would like.
- Noun - a word that represents a person, place, or thing.
- Adjective - a word that describes a noun (shape, colour, size, nationality, etc.) In Spanish adjectives follow the noun they describe e.g. un gato blanco
- Subordination – use the word because to join a sentence.



Sticky Knowledge:

- Name food items on a menu.
- Order a meal using the conditional tense *Me gustaría*.
- Follow cooking instructions using commands.
- Use opinions to say if you like / dislike a food item *Me gusta /no me gusta*.
- Use a subordination to say why you like / dislike something *porque*.
- Use it is *es* to give a justification.

- No me gusta* – I don't like
- Me encanta* – I love
- Odio* – I hate
- Prefiero* – I prefer
- ¿Te gusta?* – Do you like?
