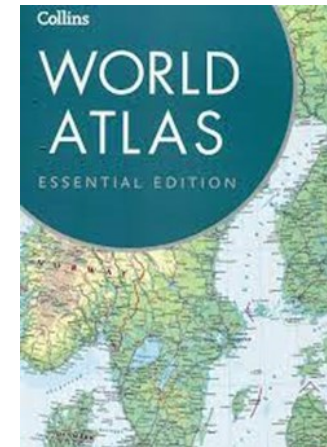

Glossary:

- Continent- any of the world's main expanses of land.
- Ocean- a very large expanse of sea, in particular each of the main areas into which the sea is divided geographically.
- Country- a nation with its own government, occupying a particular territory.
- Globe- a spherical, rounded object representing the Earth.
- Atlas- a book of maps of the world, in either lots of detail or more general.
- Human feature- a feature that has been built or put there by civilisation.
- Physical feature- a feature that exists naturally and has not been placed somewhere for a purpose.
- Equator - invisible line that runs around the centre of the Earth.
