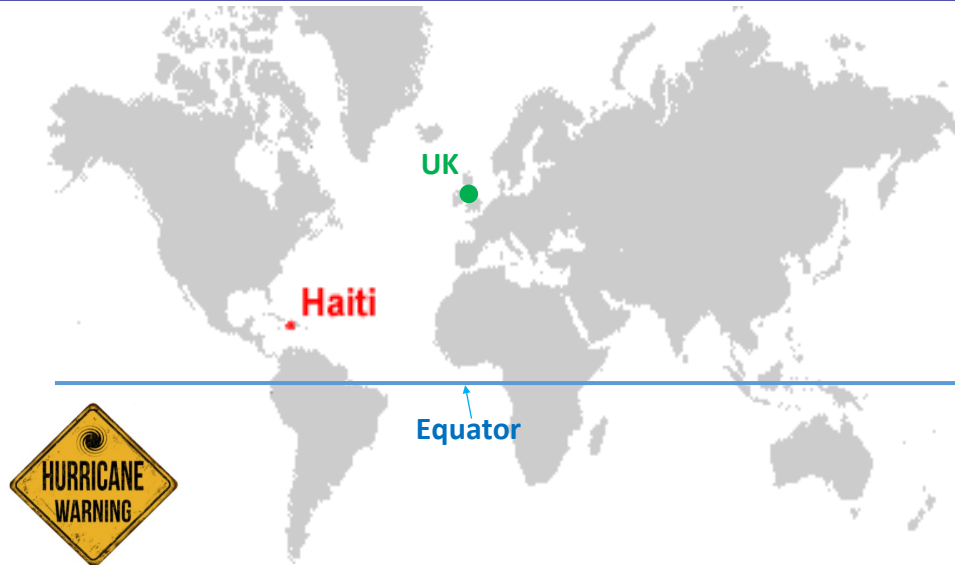

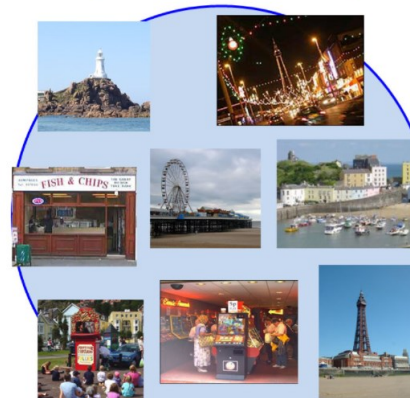

Glossary:

- Equator: an imaginary line around the middle of Earth to divide it into two, halfway between the North and South poles.
- Population: The number of people in a single area.
- Vegetation: The plant life of a region, all ground covered by plants.
- Climate: the weather conditions in an area.
- Hurricane: A storm with a violent wind.
- Storm: a violent disturbance of the atmosphere with strong winds and usually rain, thunder, lightning, or snow.
- MPH: Miles per hour, used to show how fast someone or something is travelling.
- Grid references: A map reference indicating a location
