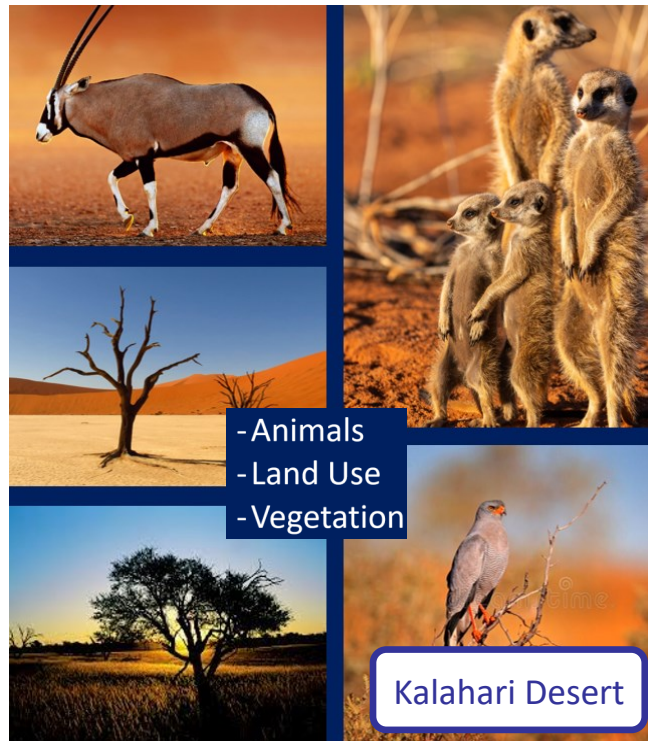

## Kalahari Desert

### Glossary:

- Northern Hemisphere – North of the equator
- Southern Hemisphere – South of the equator
- Desert – gets very little rain, can be hot or cold, and sandy or rocky
- Climate – The weather conditions in an area
- Equator – An imaginary line around the middle of Earth to divide it into two, halfway between the North and South poles.
- Habitat – the natural home or environment of an animal or plant
- Vegetation – The plant life of a region, all ground covered by plants.
- Tourism – people travelling to and staying in places outside their usual environment
- Pollution – harmful materials in the environment
